Lyon also goes undercover herself, posting an online ad, and taking calls from solicitors -- and Internet pimps -- to understand more about how girls are victimized by sex traffickers.

An interactive map on CNN.com shares Lyon's coast-to-coast journey -- from Maryland, Missouri, Tennessee and Nevada -- trailing runaways, finding their families, meeting sex workers, and visiting a "Johns' school" where convicted solicitors are forced to face the social and criminal consequences of their actions.

23) Teens as Young as 13 Rescued From Super Bowl Sex Trafficking

Feb 5, 2014 = > Sixteen teenagers ranging in age from 13 to 17 were recovered by law enforcement in a crackdown on child trafficking surrounding the Super Bowl last weekend. The FBI said the teens included high school students and young people reported missing by their families.

"It is the most significant operation we've had around a big event," Michael Osborne of the FBI's Violent Crimes Against Children Unit told ABC News. "This is the most recoveries we've had at one time."

Officials said the vast majority of the rescued teens were very young girls.

Osborne said he calls taking the young people off the street "recoveries," because the children are **not** charged.

In child exploitation cases like this, law enforcement officials said operations are designed to remove the young victims from a life of sexual exploitation and abuse.

"These recoveries are victim-focused," Osborn said. "Many times these young people are kept in this life by pimps using sexual, physical and emotional abuse."

The law enforcement effort to help the young victims goes well beyond providing overnight food, clothing and shelter, Osborne said. Over the course of the operation, the FBI's victim specialists' provided 70 women and children referrals to health care facilities, shelters, and other programs.

Osborne said the FBI works with social service specialists to provide for the long-term needs of the victims as well.

"We provide everything we can to try to pull them out of their situation, like education information and family counseling," Osborne said. The family counseling, he explained, is needed because many of the young girls who end up being exploited are runaways. "We know there is a very close correlation between runaway girls and prostitution."

What is striking in many cases, he said, is that the young victims themselves don't think they deserve the help. "They don't think they are worth saving," Osborne said. "Sometimes we are the only people in their lives who haven't given up on them."

The crackdown also identified and arrested 45 pimps and their associates. The arrests came in New York, New Jersey and in Connecticut in the days leading up to the Super Bowl.

Osborne said the FBI teamed with state and local law enforcement to develop intelligence about the movement of pimps and prostitutes into the vicinity of the Super Bowl, as they do with any big event, like a big game or convention.

That's because pimps and "facilitators" move girls around from state to state to find a large gathering of potential customers.

"High-profile special events, which draw large crowds, have become lucrative opportunities for child prostitution criminal enterprises," said Ron Hosko, assistant director of the FBI's Criminal Investigative Division. "The FBI and our partners remain committed to stopping this cycle of victimization and putting those who try to profit from this type of criminal activity behind bars."

Osborne said many times, prostitutes are **not** walking the streets anymore, but rather their services are offered on internet sites by their pimps.

"No doubt about it, we had a lot of internet activity in the past week," Osborne said.

32) Trafficking of Children in the United States: Documentary Film

Jun 30, 2012 = > Trafficking of children is a form of human trafficking and is defined as the "recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring, and/or receipt" of a child for the purpose of exploitation.

Though statistics regarding the magnitude of child trafficking are difficult to obtain, the International Labor Organization estimates that 1.2 million children are trafficked each year.

The trafficking of children has been internationally recognized as a major human rights violation, one that exists in every region of the world.

Yet, it is only within the past decade that the prevalence and ramifications of this practice have risen to international prominence, due to a dramatic increase in research and public action. A variety of potential solutions have accordingly been suggested and implemented, which can be categorized as four types of action: broad protection, prevention, law enforcement, and victim assistance. Major international documents regarding child trafficking include the 1989 U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child, the 1999 I.L.O. Worst Forms of Child Labor Convention, and the 2000 U.N. Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, especially Women and Children.

Commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC) constitutes a form of coercion and violence against children and amounts to forced labor and a contemporary form of slavery.

A declaration of the World Congress against Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children, held in Stockholm in 1996, defined CSEC as: 'sexual abuse by the adult and remuneration in cash or kind to the child or a third person or persons. The child is treated as a sexual object and as a commercial object.'

CSEC includes the prostitution of children, child pornography, child sex tourism and other forms of transactional sex where a child engages in sexual activities to have key needs fulfilled, such as food, shelter or access to education.

It includes forms of transactional sex where the sexual abuse of children is not stopped or reported by household members, due to benefits derived by the household from the perpetrator. CSEC also potentially includes arranged marriages involving children under the age of 18 years, where the child has not freely consented to marriage and where the child is sexually abused.

Prostitution of children under the age of 18 years, child pornography and the (often related) sale and trafficking of children are often considered to be crimes of violence against children. They are considered to be forms of economic exploitation akin to forced labor or slavery.

Such children often suffer irreparable damage to their physical and mental health. They face early pregnancy and risk sexually transmitted diseases, particularly AIDS. They are often inadequately protected by the law and may be treated as criminals.

Child trafficking and CSEC sometimes overlap. On the one hand, children who are trafficked are often trafficked for the purposes of CSEC. However, not all trafficked children are trafficked for these purposes.

Further, even if some of the children trafficked for other forms of work are subsequently sexually abused at work, this does not necessarily constitute CSEC. On the other hand, according to the U.S. Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000, the definition of Severe Forms of Trafficking in Persons includes any commercial sex act performed by a person under the age of 18. This means that any minor who is commercially sexually exploited is defined as a trafficking victim, whether or not movement has taken place. CSEC is also part of, but distinct from, child abuse, or even child sexual abuse. Child rape, for example, will not usually constitute CSEC.

Neither will domestic violence.

Although CSEC is considered as child labor, and indeed one of the worst forms of child labor, in terms of international conventions, in legislation, policy and programmatic terms, CSEC is often treated as a form of child abuse or a crime.

34) Children for sale: Sex traffickers targeting Americans

May 17, 2012 = > When people speak about the sex trafficking market, experts say it not surprising to hear about places like Thailand, India, some European countries and even Mexico.

"It's like this underworld activity that most Americans just don't realize," Jenny Clark, associate professor at South Texas College in McAllen, said.

Experts on the human and sex trafficking markets gathered for a conference in McAllen, to discuss the multimillion dollar, international industry, that's quickly spreading to new markets, including right here in the Rio Grande Valley.

"In my mind it was always in the far east, in the Middle East, maybe in Africa but certainly not in the developed nations and not in our country," Family Crisis Center Executive Director Brenda Heredia said. "Much to our horror it is - it is a reality here in the United States and here in the Valley."

Heredia said she was alerted by the FBI recently, that sex traffickers are making bold moves. They are scouting middle and elementary schools, looking for their victims.

American born children that sex traffickers are mostly looking for, are children with low self-esteem, experts said.

But this market is **no** child's play - **sex** trafficking is a lucrative business.

It's estimated these criminals make hundreds of thousands, if **not** millions of dollars off each **sex** victim.

"One victim of sex trafficking in one day services as many as 50 men -- 50!" Heredia said.

"That tells you, over the course of a week, hundreds of people are taking advantage of this."

If one sex victim services 50 clients per day, and charges a minimum of \$50 dollars per client, the victim could service up to 350 clients per week. That would translate to a minimum of \$17,000.

Heredia also said criminals are looking to get anywhere from 10 to 15 years of service out of each victim.

That means from just one sex victim, traffickers can make anywhere from \$8.4 million to \$12.6 million, over the course of 10 to 15 years.

Getting the most bank out of each victim is one of the reasons, Heredia said, the average age of sex trafficking victims has drastically decreased.

"We're talking 12, 13, 14, 15 years of age," Heredia said. "The age now for average sex trafficking victims is now 12 years of age! If you can easily get a child, think about that, it's (their) investment - it's more long term now. (They've) got 10 to 15 good years that (they) will be making money on this individual - not so with older ones."

Sex traffickers are subtle in luring children, they don't just snatch children from the streets, Heredia said. Instead, they methodically lure and "groom" them using the same techniques as child predators.

"They'll befriend them say, 'would you like to go get a hamburger, can in give you this present?" Heredia said.

It could take just days or months to spot the child they want, experts said, but once they find that vulnerable victim, sex traffickers move in fast.

"It takes within 24 to 48 hours of a young girl running away from home for a pimp to approach her -- literally," Clark said. "And that sort of figure is really startling."

Common spots where sex traffickers like to make fast and easy money are truck stops, Clark added.

"If you drive from (the Valley) to Houston, and you stop at any of the truck stops at night, you see young girls all the time," Clark said. "In fact, if you look at the truck drivers, they often have bumper stickers that say 'no lot lizards."

I've interviewed some truck drivers and they (tell me) things like, 'I go and get a cup of coffee and I come back to my truck into my cabin, and literally there's a young girl sitting next to me.' One truck driver said, 'you know you're like about 12 years old, go home!'' Clark said.

Heredia said several years ago, she dealt with two American girls that came from middle class, average families who ended up as sex trafficking victims.

She said they were from Texas, **not** far from the Valley, and made their money at truck **stops** for about two years.

"A young girl who was over 18 wanted to get away from home - wanted to get away and go to the big city so she ran away," Heredia said. "She was hitch hiking so within 24 hours of her running away, somebody who picked her up bought her a meal... (and) bought her new clothes, very seductive clothing," Heredia said.

In return, Heredia said, the pimp forced the girl to pay him back for the food and clothes by working as a prostitute at truck stops.

Of the three cases of Texas children lured into sex trafficking - which were from Houston, Austin and San Antonio - Heredia said she knows of just one being rescued.

Clark and Heredia agree that parental vigilance over their children's behavior and activities, especially on the Internet, is what could make the difference in preventing them from becoming a sex trafficking victims.

"When there is a dollar to be made," Heredia said. "The traffickers will move in and take advantage."

Human trafficking is the modern form of slavery, with illegal smuggling and trading of people, for forced labor or sexual exploitation.

Trafficking is officially defined as the recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring, or receipt of persons by means of coercion, abduction, fraud, deception, or abuse of power of a position of vulnerability for the purpose of exploitation. Human trafficking is **not** synonymous with forced migration or smuggling.

In the U.S., human trafficking tends to occur around international travel-hubs with large immigrant populations, notably California and Texas. The U.S. Justice Department estimates that 17,500 people are trafficked into the country every year, but the true figure could be higher, because of the large numbers of undocumented immigrants. Those being trafficked include young children, teenagers, men and women and can be domestic citizens or foreign nationals. According to the Department of State's statistics from 2000, there are approximately 244,000 American children and youth that are at risk for sex trafficking each year. Of these children and youth, 38,600 were originally runaways.

Under Federal law, it is a crime to make people work by use of force, coercion, or fear.

The regulation of prostitution in the United States is **not** among the enumerated powers of the federal government. Under the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, it is therefore exclusively the domain of the states to permit, prohibit, or otherwise regulate commercial **sex**, except insofar as Congress may regulate it as part of interstate commerce with laws like the Mann Act. In most states, prostitution is considered a misdemeanor in the category of public order crime, a crime that disrupts the order of a community. It was at one time considered to be a vagrancy crime.

Currently, Nevada is the only state to allow legal prostitution - in the form of regulated brothels - the terms of which are stipulated in the Nevada Revised Statutes. Only 8 counties currently contain active brothels. All forms of prostitution are illegal in Clark County (which contains the Las Vegas–Paradise metropolitan area), Washoe County (which contains Reno), Carson City, Douglas County, and Lincoln County.

The other counties theoretically allow brothel prostitution, but some of these counties currently have **no** active brothels. Street prostitution, "pandering," and living off of the proceeds of a prostitute remain illegal under Nevada law, as elsewhere in the country.

As with other countries, prostitution in the United States can be divided into three broad categories: street prostitution, brothel prostitution, and escort prostitution.

80) Trafficking of Children in the United States: Documentary Film

Jun 30, 2012 = > Trafficking of children is a form of human trafficking and is defined as the "recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring, and/or receipt" of a child for the purpose of exploitation.

Though statistics regarding the magnitude of child trafficking are difficult to obtain, the International Labor Organization estimates that 1.2 million children are trafficked each year.

The trafficking of children has been internationally recognized as a major human rights violation, one that exists in every region of the world. Yet, it is only within the past decade that the prevalence and ramifications of this practice have risen to international prominence, due to a dramatic increase in research and public action. A variety of potential solutions have accordingly been suggested and implemented, which can be categorized as four types of action: broad protection, prevention, law enforcement, and victim assistance. Major international documents regarding child trafficking include the 1989 U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child, the 1999 I.L.O. Worst Forms of Child Labor Convention, and the 2000 U.N. Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, especially Women and Children.

Commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC) constitutes a form of coercion and violence against children and amounts to forced labor and a contemporary form of slavery.

A declaration of the World Congress against Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children, held in Stockholm in 1996, defined CSEC as: 'sexual abuse by the adult and remuneration in cash or kind to the child or a third person or persons. The child is treated as a sexual object and as a commercial object.'

CSEC includes the prostitution of children, child pornography, child sex tourism and other forms of transactional sex where a child engages in sexual activities to have key needs fulfilled, such as food, shelter or access to education. It includes forms of transactional sex where the sexual abuse of children is not stopped or reported by household members, due to benefits derived by the household from the perpetrator.

CSEC also potentially includes arranged marriages involving children under the age of 18 years, where the child has **not** freely consented to marriage and where the child is **sexually** abused.

Prostitution of children under the age of 18 years, child pornography and the (often related) sale and trafficking of children are often considered to be crimes of violence against children. They are considered to be forms of economic exploitation akin to forced labor or slavery. Such children often suffer irreparable damage to their physical and mental health. They face early pregnancy and risk sexually transmitted diseases, particularly AIDS. They are often inadequately protected by the law and may be treated as criminals.

Child trafficking and CSEC sometimes overlap. On the one hand, children who are trafficked are often trafficked for the purposes of CSEC. However, **not** all trafficked children are trafficked for these purposes. Further, even if some of the children trafficked for other forms of work are subsequently **sexually** abused at work, this does **not** necessarily constitute CSEC.

On the other hand, according to the U.S. Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000, the definition of Severe Forms of Trafficking in Persons includes any commercial sex act performed by a person under the age of 18. This means that any minor who is commercially sexually exploited is defined as a trafficking victim, whether or not movement has taken place. CSEC is also part of, but distinct from, child abuse, or even child sexual abuse. Child rape, for example, will not usually constitute CSEC. Neither will domestic violence.

Although CSEC is considered as child labor, and indeed one of the worst forms of child labor, in terms of international conventions, in legislation, policy and programmatic terms, CSEC is often treated as a form of child abuse or a crime.

Trafficking victims, including undocumented individuals, are eligible for services and immigration assistance.

- 3. Be a conscientious and informed consumer. Discover your <u>slavery footprint</u>, ask <u>who picked your tomatoes</u> or <u>made your clothes</u>, or check out the Department of Labor's <u>List of Goods Produced by Child Labor or Forced Labor</u>. <u>Encourage companies</u> to take steps to investigate and prevent human trafficking in their supply chains and publish the information for consumer awareness.
